Macon-Bibb County has provided a service to expedite reporting for some of the problems we see in our community. Usually, I will field a call from an industry, go out to the spot and take a photo, then submit it through the 'See. Click. Fix.' website. You have the same capability to do so as well- even faster- by navigating to the website and following the prompts. You will first have to set up a username and password, but after that, it is a snap!

I have submitted requests for anything from trash to dead animals on the parkway. Some of the more urgent requests that are handled quickly are down traffic signs or signals and things that are an immediate threat to our community. The city also has the capability to patch potholes; however, you may have to wait until they are in that part of the city with the truck.
